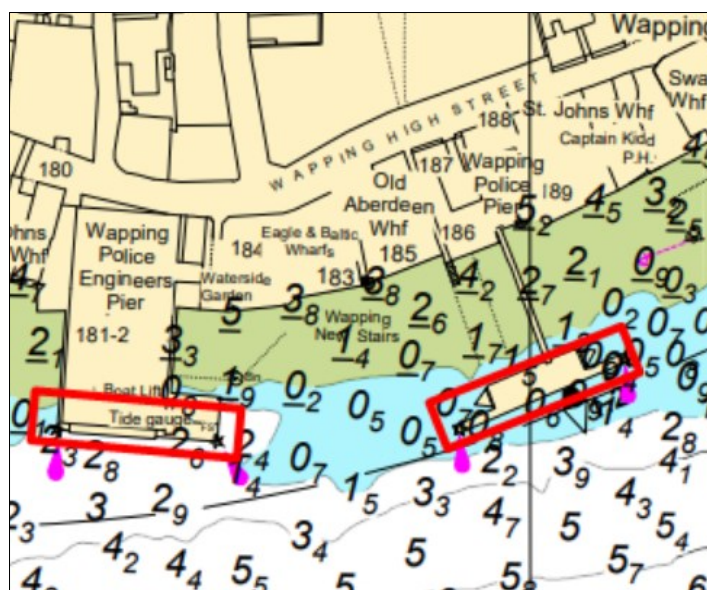
WAPPING POLICE PIER & ENGINEERING PIER FENDER REPLACEMENT OPERATIONS

This notice replaces Notice to Mariners M89-23, which is hereby cancelled

On or about Monday 9th October 2023, marine contractors working on behalf of the Marine Policing Unit will be undertaking fender replacement operations on the Police Pier and Engineering Pier, which will take approximately 10-weeks.

These operations will be undertaken from and supported by modular pontoons to replace the fendering to the piers. Tug PROTECTOR will be in attendance to manoeuvre the modular pontoons around the works site. Operations are expected to take place seven days a week, between the hours of 07:00 to 18:00.

The chartlet below indicates the approximate footprint of the marine works.



Requirements to proceed with caution or at slow speed will be made in accordance with the procedure set out in the Port of London Authority's [Port Information Guide](#), under 'London VTS', 'Section 4' with the International Code Flags 'Romeo Yankee (RY)' displayed.



Further details will be broadcast by London VTS on **VHF Channel 14** as required.
