




## KINGS REACH

## BLACKFRIARS ROAD & RAIL BRIDGES - ARCH RESTRICTIONS

On or about **14<sup>th</sup> March 2024** FM Conway will be installing new cabling under Blackfriars Road Bridge. These works are expected to take place overnight between 2300 and 0530, and last for 5 nights.

In order to accommodate these works, illuminated tiger stripe boards will be deployed on the bridge deck of both Blackfriars Road Bridge and Blackfriars Rail Bridge, marking the extremities of an area in Arch 3 against the southern abutment. Vessels must not navigate in the area between the tiger stripe and the nearest abutment, as depicted below. The navigable arch width will not be reduced by more than 10 metres.



The arch restrictions will be in place as follows:
