

NOTICE TO MARINERS M2 of 2021

KINGS REACH WATERLOO BRIDGE ARCH CLOSURES & LOCAL TRAFFIC CONTROL

Abseiler's working on behalf of Transport for London will be conducting survey operations on Waterloo Bridge from **Monday 25th January 2021** until **Saturday 30th January 2021**. In order to accommodate these works, arches on Waterloo Bridge will be closed to navigation as follows:

Local Traffic Control will be undertaken from a PLA Harbour Service Launch exhibiting a flashing blue light in the vicinity of Waterloo Bridge during the closure of Arches No. 2 and 3. All vessels intending to navigate between Westminster Bridge and Blackfriars Rail Bridge are to call '**WATERLOO CONTROL**' on VHF Channel 14 as follows:

- Outbound at Westminster Bridge
- Inbound Blackfriars Rail Bridge
- Prior to leaving a berth or mooring between Westminster Bridge and Blackfriars Rail Bridge.

Safety Boat **PROWLER** will be in attendance throughout these operations and will be maintaining a listening watch on VHF Channel 14.

Arches closed to navigation will be marked in accordance with the Port of London Authority Thames Byelaws 2012 namely:

- By day, three red discs 0.6 metres in diameter at the points of an equilateral triangle with the apex downwards and the base horizontal
- By night, three red lights in similar positions to the discs displayed by day.

Further details will be broadcast by **London VTS** on VHF Channel 14.
