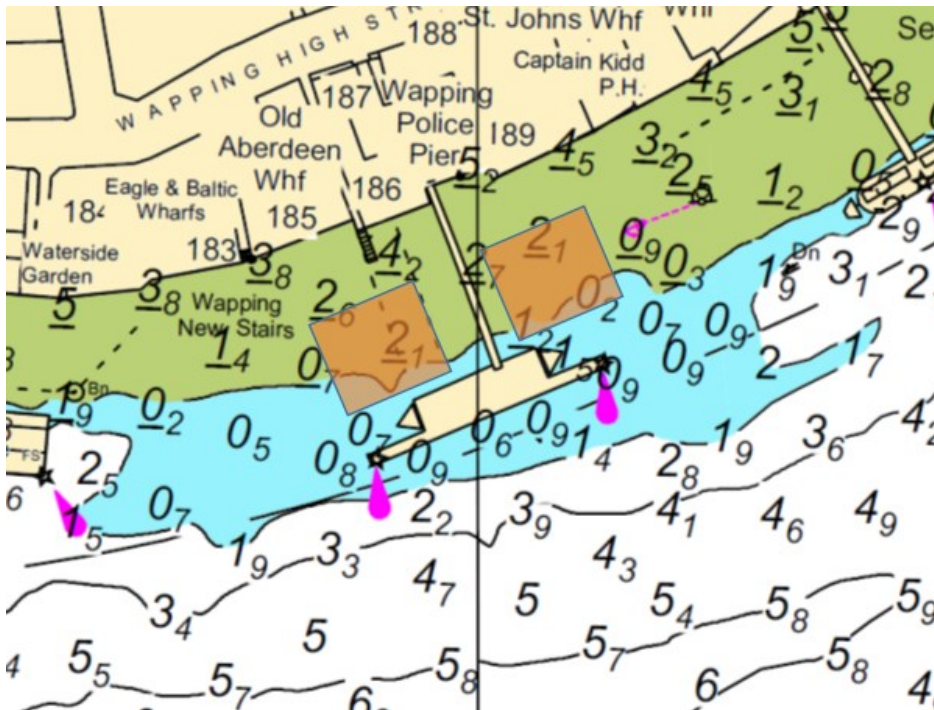


NOTICE TO MARINERS M56 of 2020

LOWER POOL WAPPING POLICE PIER URGENT REPAIR WORKS

On or about 2nd December 2020 contractors working on behalf of the Metropolitan Police will undertake repair works on Wapping Police Pier, which are anticipated to take approximately five weeks. The chartlet below depicts the two locations from which the Haven Seaway will effect repairs.



Working hours will be 08:00 until 18:00 Monday to Friday and Sat 08:00 until 13:00 with no work taking place on Sunday.

London VTS will broadcast requests for vessels to “proceed with caution” or “proceed at slow speed”, as described in Permanent Notices to Mariners 4 of 2014 as required by the works. International Code Flags “Romeo Yankee” will be displayed when this is in effect.

Further details will be broadcast by London VTS on VHF Channel 14 as required.
