

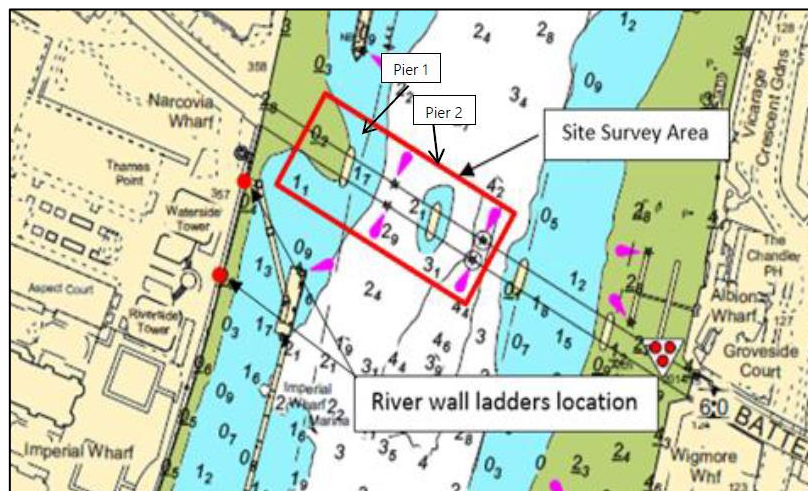
NOTICE TO MARINERS M63 of 2018

BATTERSEA REACH

BATTERSEA RAIL BRIDGE DRONE SURVEY

On or about the 25 September 2018 contractors working on the Tideway Tunnel Project will survey Battersea Rail Bridge using a drone being controlled by an operator from a RIB.

Please see the chartlet below depicting the survey area.



The RIB TRISTAR will display a sign with the word SURVEY in large letters, fly international code flags IR and maintain a continuous listening watch on VHF Channel 14.

The RIB TRISTAR will not obstruct other vessels using the arches and the drone will not be flown within 50 metres of passing vessels. The survey is expected to start at 0730 and take approximately 3 hours.

Vessels are requested to be mindful of the survey and if there is any doubt that the RIB TRISTAR or drone is not complying with the above to communicate their doubt directly to the RIB TRISTAR and report to London VTS.

Further details will be broadcast by London VTS on VHF Channel 14.
