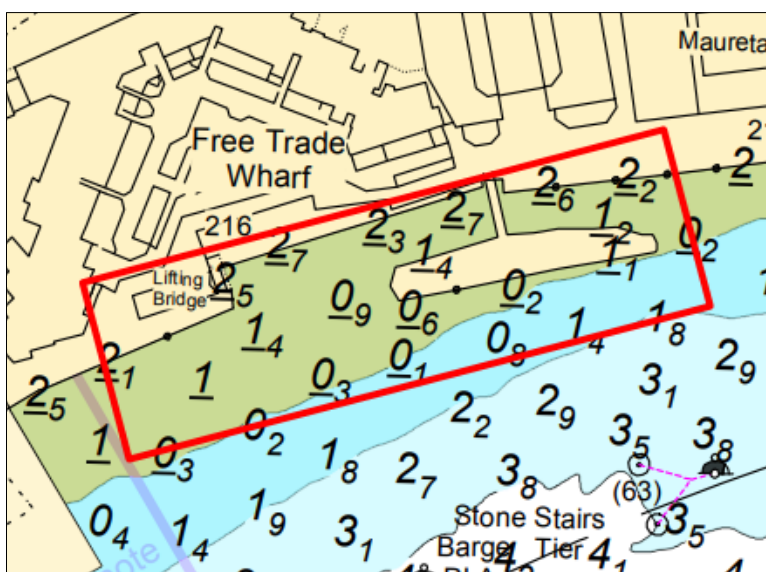


## LOWER POOL FREE TRADE WHARF EMERGENCY DEMOLITION WORKS

On or about Monday 10<sup>th</sup> July 2023, marine contractors working on behalf of Free Trade Wharf Management Company will commence emergency demolition works on the timber structures at Free Trade Wharf and associated jetties.

These operations will take place using a variety of vessels including; crane barges, supply barges, Multi-Cats, tugs and work boats and expected to take approximately six months. Usual operational hours are Monday to Saturday during the hours of 07:00 to 18:00 (13:00 on Saturday's).

An area of 'works in progress' will be established around the site for the duration of the works as indicated on the chartlet below.



Throughout these operations Notice to Mariners [M66 of 2023](#) remains in force and must be complied with.

A safety boat will be on station maintaining a listening watch on VHF Channel 14.

Further details will be broadcast by London VTS on **VHF Channel 14** as required.
