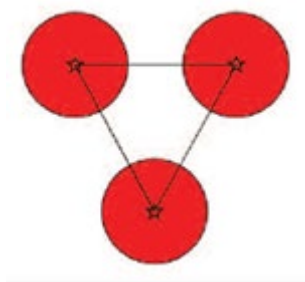
SOUTHWARK BRIDGE ARCH CLOSURES

On or about Monday **12th February 2024**, contractors will commence installing new CCTV cabling on Southwark Bridge. These works are expected to take place overnight and last up to 5 weeks. In order to accommodate the works arches will be Closed to Navigation overnight as follows:

Arch	Start Date	End Date	Time	Navigational Information
1 & 2	Monday 12 th February 2024	Sunday 25 th February 2024	2200 - 0500	Closed to Navigation
4 & 5	Monday 26 th February 2024	Wednesday 06 th March 2024	2200 - 0500	Closed to Navigation
3	Wednesday 6 th March 2024	Wednesday 13 th March 2024	2300 - 0530	Closed to Navigation

Arches closed to navigation will be marked in accordance with the Port of London Authority Thames Byelaws 2012 namely:

- By day, three red discs 0.6 metres in diameter at the points of an equilateral triangle with the apex downwards and the base horizontal.
- By night, three red lights in similar positions to the discs displayed by day.



Safety Boat **PRONTO** will be in attendance throughout these operations and will be maintaining a listening watch on VHF Channel 14.

Further details will be broadcast by **London VTS** on **VHF Channel 14**.
