GOLDEN JUBILEE FOOTBRIDGES & CHARING CROSS RAILWAY BRIDGE ARCH CLOSURES

Commencing on or about **Monday 4th March 2024** until on or about **Thursday 21st March 2024**, contractors working on behalf of Westminster City Council will be conducting abseiling works from various locations on the Golden Jubilee Footbridges Upper and Lower. In order to accommodate these works, arches of the two Footbridges and that of Charing Cross Railway Bridge will be closed to navigation as follows:

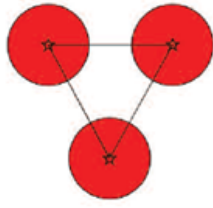
