BATTERSEA REACH BATTERSEA RAIL BRIDGE ARCH CLOSURES

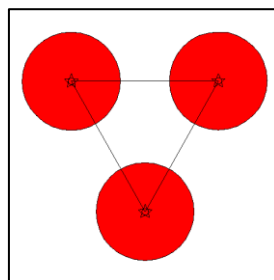
Contractors working on behalf of Network Rail will be conducting diving operations on Battersea Rail Bridge from **Monday 30th May 2022 to Wednesday 1st June 2022**. In order to accommodate these works, arches on Battersea Rail Bridge will be closed to navigation as follows:

Local Traffic Control will be undertaken from a PLA Harbour Service Launch in the vicinity of Battersea Rail Bridge for the duration of the closures in arch 2. All vessels intending to navigate between Wandsworth Bridge and Albert Bridge are to call '**BATTERSEA CONTROL**' on VHF Channel 14 as follows:

- Inbound at Albert Bridge
- Outbound at Wandsworth Bridge
- Prior to leaving a berth or mooring between Albert Bridge and Wandsworth Bridge

Arches closed to navigation will be marked in accordance with the Port of London Authority Thames Byelaws 2012:
