WANDSWORTH BRIDGE ARCH CLOSURES

Commencing on or about **Tuesday 2nd April 2024,** contractors working on behalf of Wandsworth Council will be conducting works including abseiling on Wandsworth Bridge for the maintenance and testing of the bridge lighting. In order to accommodate these works, arches of Wandsworth Bridge will be closed to navigation as follows:







Local Traffic Control will be in attendance during the closure of **ARCH 2** which will be undertaken from a PLA Harbour Service Launch exhibiting a flashing blue light positioned in the vicinity of Wandsworth Bridge. They will advise contractors to pause works to facilitate the passage of vessels intending to navigate through arch 2 of Wandsworth Bridge. All vessels are to call '**WANDSWORTH CONTROL**' on VHF Channel 14 as follows:

15 minutes prior to arrival at the bridge.

Arches closed to navigation will be marked in accordance with the Port of London Authority (PLA) Thames Byelaws 2012 as depicted and by night lit with three red lights in a downward triangle.



During the closures of arches 1 & 3, black and yellow tiger stripes will be displayed up to a maximum of 10 meters from the abutment within arch 2. This should be considered as an extension to the arch closure and closed to navigation.



Further details will be broadcast by **London VTS** on VHF Channel 14.
