BARN ELMS REACH TO MORTLAKE REACH LIGHTWEIGHT TRIAL EIGHT RACES

The Lightweight University Boat Race will be holding four Trial Eight races between Putney Bridge and Chiswick Bridge at the following times:

Friday 13th December 2019

- First Trial between 12:00 and 12:30
- Second Trial between 12:30 and 13:00
- Third Trial between 13:30 and 14:00
- Fourth Trial between 14:00 and 14:30

Each race will consist of two 'eights' racing with the flood tide from the University Stone at Putney to the Boat Race finish post at Chiswick. These sessions will be followed by no more than two accompanying launches.

Vessels navigating in the area during these times should take note of the following:

- Rowing vessels will be racing but are also required to navigate in accordance with the International Regulations for Preventing Collisions at Sea, 1972 (COLREGS).
- Rowing vessels and coaching launches not involved in the races are to avoid obstructing the races and the following vessels;
- Motor vessels in the area are to be aware of the race and are to navigate with caution, keeping wash to a minimum.

Further details will be broadcast by London VTS on VHF Channel 14.
